2012 Meeting Schedule

The Citizens Flood Control Advisory Board (FCAB) is a seven-member committee of appointed citizens which acts in an advisory role to the Flood Control District's Board of Directors on flood control, floodplain management, drainage and related matters. The FCAB reviews planning, operations and maintenance of flood control facilities, and recommends an annual budget, which includes a five-year Capital Improvement Program (CIP).

FCAB Bylaws, Article V, Section 1, state that regular meetings of the FCAB shall be held on the fourth Wednesday of each month, except for December when the meeting shall be held on the first Wednesday of the month. Meetings are not scheduled in July or November, unless called by the Chairman of the FCAB.

All regular FCAB meetings are held at 2:00 p.m. in the New River Conference Room of the Flood Control District administrative office located at 2801 West Durango Street, Phoenix, Arizona. Meeting sessions are open to the public.
