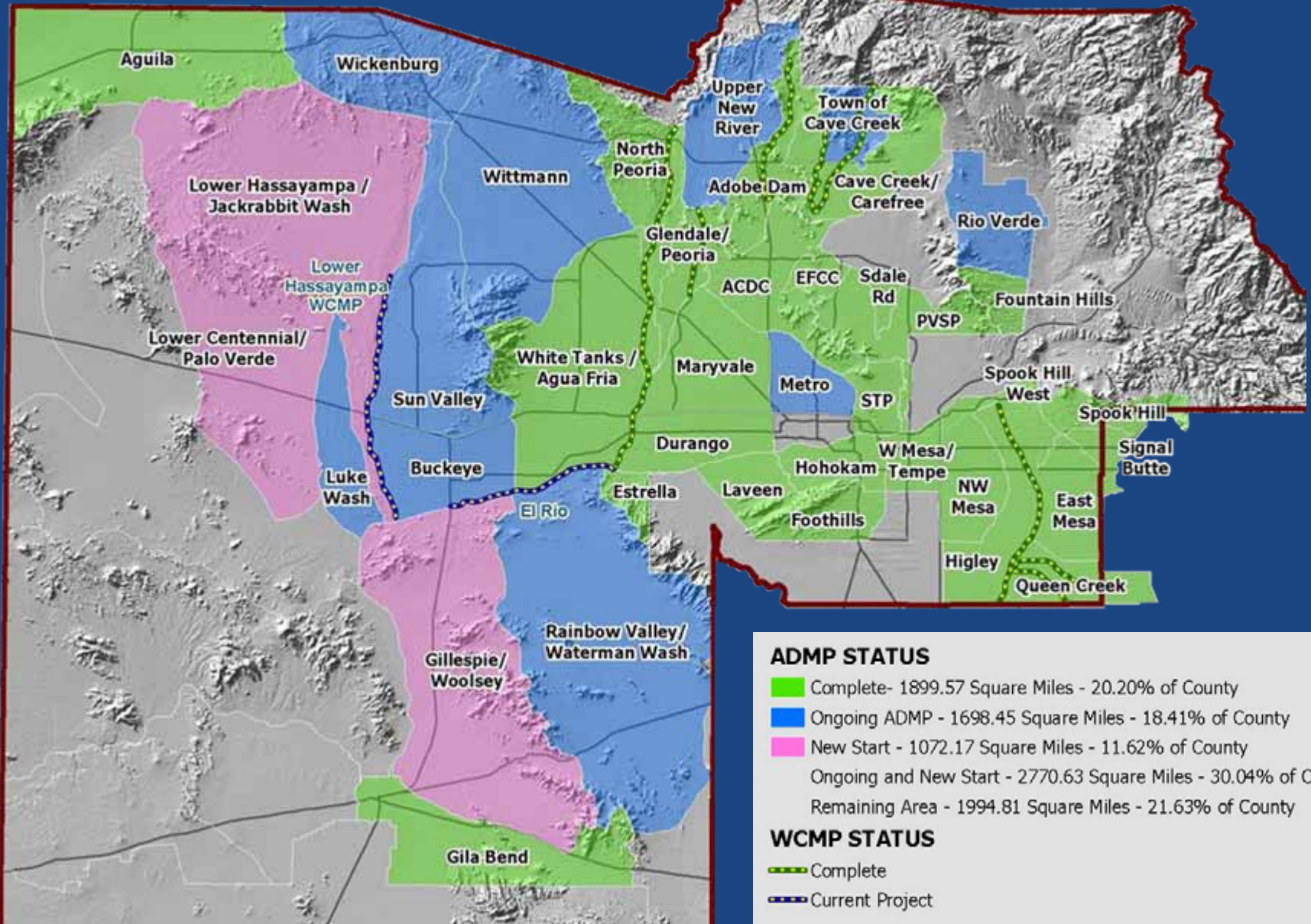
Planning Program Purpose
