

Metro Phoenix Area Drainage Master Plan

The Flood Control District of Maricopa County (District) is conducting the third series of public meetings for the Metro Phoenix Area Drainage Master Plan (Metro ADMP). The Metro ADMP is intended to quantify the extent of drainage and flooding problems in the Metro Phoenix study area (see map) and to develop alternative measures to mitigate identified concerns.

At each public meeting, the study team will present alternative drainage measures and solicit your comments, and will also present the potential changes to the Cave Creek floodplain boundary.


The District will submit the proposed floodplain delineation to the Federal Emergency Management Agency for review and approval. If approved, a number of properties may be removed from the existing floodplain.
