

The Flood Control District of Maricopa County (District), in cooperation with the Towns of Gilbert and Queen Creek, is conducting a public meeting for the Sonoqui Wash Channelization project. The District is designing a multiuse channel capable of containing a 100-year flood within the existing alignment of the Sonoqui Wash from Queen Creek Wash (Higley Road) to Chandler Heights Road. The project includes a predesign study to determine the exact alignment and capacity of the Sonoqui Wash Channel and evaluate equestrian and multiuse recreational facilities appropriate for the area.

This is the initial public meeting in an effort to keep citizens informed and involved in each step of the process. The purpose of this meeting is to provide information regarding the project and to receive public feedback. The meeting will be in an open house format with exhibits displaying project information. The project team will also be available to discuss the project and answer your questions.
