



Wittmann Area Drainage Master Plan

Welcome to the public meeting for the Wittmann Area Drainage Master Plan (ADMP). The Flood Control District of Maricopa County (District) is addressing regional drainage and flooding problems in the study area (see back page). The ADMP study team has completed an extensive alternative evaluation effort that resulted in development of the draft recommended alternative presented in this handout. The purpose of the August public meeting is to present this draft recommended alternative and provide study area residents and business owners with an opportunity to comment on it.



Study Purpose

The objectives of the ADMP are to identify flooding and erosion hazards and develop cost-effective solutions. The goal of the ADMP is to develop a comprehensive drainage master plan that will be used and implemented by the county, cities, land management agencies, and developers for the implementation of future flood control and drainage projects.

Study Area

The Wittmann ADMP study area is approximately 310 square miles and is located within the city of Surprise and unincorporated Maricopa County. Approximately 40 percent of the land in the study area is State Trust Land. Private ownership accounts for 30 percent of the land, and the federal and local governments own the remaining 30 percent.
