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MEMO re FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT OF MARICOPA COUNTY
In re: PROPOSED BOND ELECTION

Following the approval of the comprehensive program of flood control by the Board of Directors of the Flood Control District, the Board of Directors may submit to the electors of the District qualified to vote thereon, the proposition of incurring bonded indebtedness of the District to obtain funds for the acquisition by purchase, construction or otherwise of the facilities approved in the report. The comprehensive program was approved by the Board of Directors of the Flood Control District of Maricopa County in November, 1963. The Citizens Flood Control Advisory Board recommended the approval of the comprehensive program of flood control and the submission to the electors of the Flood Control District the proposition of incurring a bonded indebtedness for the purpose of implementing the comprehensive program. Therefore, pursuant to Section 45-2362, the question is now before the Board of Directors whether the comprehensive program they have approved be acquired and operated from available funds of the District, or whether to submit to the electors of the District the proposition of incurring the bonded indebtedness. Because there are not funds available with which to carry out the comprehensive program, the only remaining question is the submission to the electors of the District of the proposition as to whether or not the bonded indebtedness should be incurred which will permit the comprehensive program or a part of it to be completed.

Section 45-2362 sets forth the steps that must be followed



by the Board of Directors in passing a resolution calling for a bond election. In substance, they must do the following: they must pass a resolution calling for the bond election and which sets forth the purpose of the indebtedness, referring to the comprehensive program for particulars, the amount of the indebtedness, the maximum number of years for which the indebtedness is to be incurred, the maximum rate of interest to be paid thereon, and the date of the election and shall list the voting places to be used at the election. The resolution shall constitute a notice of the election and shall be published once each week for three successive weeks in a newspaper published in the county and having general circulation in the district.

Under the rules and regulations adopted by the Board of Directors of the Flood Control District for the operation of their Board, they have provided that such a resolution can be passed at a regular or special meeting of the Board. Regular Board meetings are scheduled for 10 o'clock A. M. on Monday of each week during the year or at such other time and date as the Board of Directors may from time to time designate and such meetings are to be held in the hearing room of the Board of Supervisors of Maricopa County in the City of Phoenix, Arizona. They must have a quorum present to conduct their meeting and in the event they elect to do this by way of a special meeting, they must give notice of the special meeting to each of the Directors and the Chief Engineer and General Manager of the Flood Control District at least three (3) days prior to the date on which the special meeting is to be held. The resolution would have to be passed by the affirmative vote of the majority of the Board of Directors. They also must other-

wise comply with the rules and regulations which they have adopted for their operation.

The bond election shall be called and held and the results thereof canvassed in the same manner provided by the laws of this state for the holding of elections on the issuance of bonds for general county purposes. The Board may regard the entire district, which in this case is Maricopa County, as a single precinct or may divide it up into various precincts and polling places.

In the event a majority of the votes cast on the proposition at the bond election are in favor of incurring the bonded indebtedness, then the bonds that are authorized may be sold and issued by the Board either at one time or in blocks from time to time.

Limitations on the form, issuance and sale of the bonds and the bonded indebtedness, together with the payment of principal and interest on the bonds, are provided in detail in the statutes beginning at Section 45-2363.

LAND STATUS as of JANUARY 1962











