INTRODUCTION

The preparation and distribution of this bibliography is in response to the many inquiries made to this office concerning available planning information for Maricopa County. The sources selected for inclusion generally are those which provide the most current information or provide the fullest treatment of a particular theme. Many of the earlier works have been omitted since the data was superseded by later sources.

The bibliography is divided into five major categories: Cities, Towns and Indian Communities; Metropolitan Phoenix Area; Maricopa County; Related State Agency Reports; and Related Federal Agency Reports. Within each major category, works are listed according to one of seven general topics: Comprehensive Plans; Housing, Public Works; Recreation and Open Space; Socio-Economic; Transportation; or Special Studies. Entries are made according to their area of coverage in the case of locally published works, or according to the publisher for State and Federal works (which only partially pertain to the County or its incorporated areas). It is hoped that this format will simplify the location of current works by topic and level of geographic coverage.

We realize that the bibliography is not complete and request notification of any significant works that have been omitted. It is also requested that copies of planning related works published in the future be forwarded to this office for inclusion in future editions. At any time, suggestions are welcomed for improving future editions of the bibliography.
