- Entire County – Delegation from State of Arizona
 - Drinking Water Systems
 - Onsite Wastewater Construction
 - Wastewater Collection Systems
 - Food Handling Establishments
 - Aquatic Recreation Facilities (except residential serving up to 2 homes)
- Unincorporated, Urbanized Area Only
 - Stormwater Control for Construction Sites

Maricopa County Environmental Services Stormwater Quality Program



Pre-Construction (When to Apply)

- Construction project will disturb 1 acre or more of land
- Projects less than 1 acre, that are part of a larger common plan of development
- Project is located in the (UUA)
Unincorporated Urbanized Area

Post-Construction (When to Apply)

- Construction project installed permanent stormwater management facilities or appurtenance
- Installation or construction of new or additional impervious or semi-pervious surfaces
