



Jackrabbit Trail Corridor Improvement Study Preferred Alternatives

Public Open House

The Maricopa County Department of Transportation (MCDOT) is evaluating existing and future roadway needs for the 22-mile Jackrabbit Trail / 195th Avenue / Tuthill Road corridor between Queen Creek Road and Peoria Avenue. The segment between Van Buren Street and McDowell Road is not part of this study but is currently under a separate evaluation.

Public feedback collected at the previous Public Open House held on October 17, 2018 was used to identify Preferred Alternatives throughout the corridor.

Preferred Alternatives address potential widening and new roadway alignments. All alternatives recommend a full four lane roadway and address existing safety and future growth in the corridor. MCDOT is requesting additional comments on the identified Preferred Alternatives.

The corridor improvement study is a long range planning study and does not identify timing for funding, construction, and/or improvements.
